## 2023 Activities:

Zeuxis was founded in 2018 and has implemented various projects to provide support to vulnerable groups, especially unaccompanied minors.

In 2023, Zeuxis continued the operation of the Accommodation Centers for Unaccompanied Minor Girls (OIKOS) and Unaccompanied Minor Boys (FIVOS).

In May 2023, Zeuxis, as an IOM (International Organization for Migration) partner, started operating in the Safe Areas for Unaccompanied Migrant Children in the Reception and Identification Centers of Kos, Leros, Samos and Chios.

For the implementation of these projects, Zeuxis cooperated closely with the relevant authorities, such as the Ministry of Migration and Asylum, (the General Secretariat for vulnerable persons and Institutional Protection, the Reception and Identification Service and the Asylum Service), the Public Prosecutors, Local Authorities as well as other international and other non-profit organizations.

Zeuxis implements a Quality Management System according to the Standard ISO 9001:2015 and is registered with the Registers of the Ministry of Migration and Asylum and the Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs (as a provider of primary and secondary social services).

## Accommodation Centers for Unaccompanied Minors

The Accommodation Center for Unaccompanied Minor Girls “OIKOS” started its operation in Athens, in October 2018 and the one for Minor Boys “FIVOS” in Piraeus in March 2021, both with funding from the Swiss Ministry of Interior. They have a capacity for twenty-one (21) girls and thirty-two (32) boys respectively, who are placed by the General Secretariat for Vulnerable Persons and Institutional Protection. OIKOS and FIVOS provide safe accommodation, meals, access to healthcare and education, clothing, personal hygiene items, monthly cash allowance, internet access etc. They also provide psychosocial and legal support, as well as educational and creative recreational activities aiming at integration and preparation for independent living. The specialized and experienced staff consists of a coordinator, social workers, psychologists, educators, lawyers, interpreters, caregivers, nurses, administrative and maintenance staff.

In 2023, the two Centers were funded by the National Development program of the Hellenic Ministry of Migration and Asylum until 31/7/2023 and from the 1<sup>st</sup>/08/2023 by the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund.

In 2023, Zeuxis, as an implementing partner of the International Organization for Migration, provided protection services to Unaccompanied Minors in the Safe Areas of the Reception and Identification Centers of Kos, Leros, Samos and Chios. These services included:

- Case management/social support
- Psychological support
- Non-formal education and recreational activities
- Individual protection assistance supplies and materials.
- Transportation
- Interpretation

The Safe Area team consisted of case workers, caregivers and interpreters, who cooperated with the Reception and Identification Service, the National Organization for Public Health, the Asylum Service, the Public Prosecutors, as well as other NGOs and international organizations. The project was funded by the Swiss Federation and the Netherlands.
